The One Health Latin America Partnership Programme is an official organization and member of the World Veterinary Association and the One Health Commission. Together with the Comparative Medicine and Global Health Departments from the School of Medicine, and the Center for One Health Research (COHR) from the School of Public Health, we certificate **University of Córdoba, TIN: 891080031-3 Monteria COLOMBIA** to become an official member of the International One Health Collaborative Training and Research Interdisciplinary Partnership. The ONE HEALTH COLOMBIA was officially established in October 25 2018 during the First One Health International Symposium, at the University of Cordoba.

Faculty members, researchers and clinical professionals of the One Health Programme of several countries participate as invited Discipline Guests, Thesis Committee Members and could be available to Mentor/Co-Mentor undergraduate and graduate students through the One Health Post Graduate Programme. With this Certificate we officially welcome the University of Cordoba and One Health Colombia Commission to the One Health World community.
